

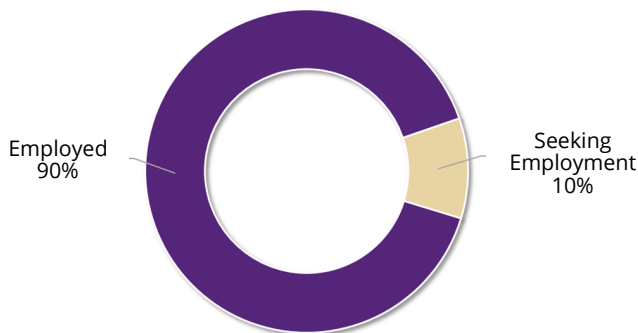
MPA EMPLOYMENT ANNUAL REPORT

The Evans School surveys all MPA students at the time of graduation and six months post-graduation to compile an annual MPA Employment Report released each Spring. For the graduating Class of 2018, we collected employment data from 115 of 147 graduates (78% of the class).

CLASS OF 2018 HIGHLIGHTS

Employment data for students graduating during academic year 2017-2018 demonstrates continued market demand for the MPA skillset and our graduates' strong commitment to public service.

90% of responding graduates found employment or were continuing education within six months after graduation.



Note: Excludes alumni who attended on international student visas, engaged in volunteer service, or did not provide employment information (32 unknown placements).

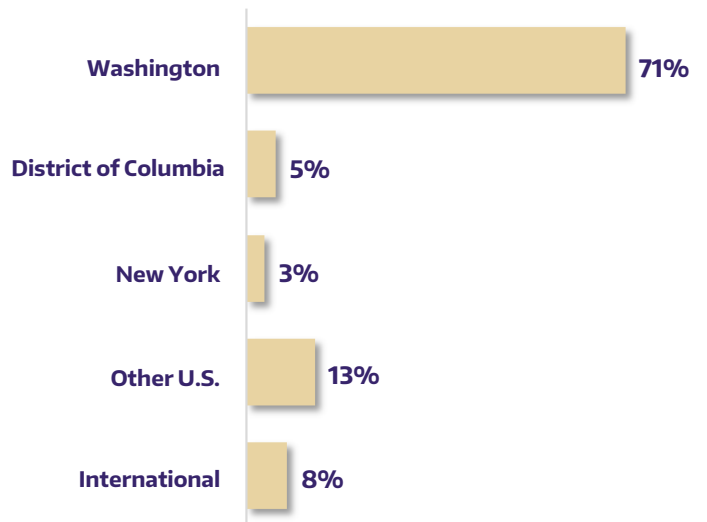
EMPLOYMENT BY LOCATION

Evans School graduates from the Class of 2018 continue to expand the global network of alumni around the world.



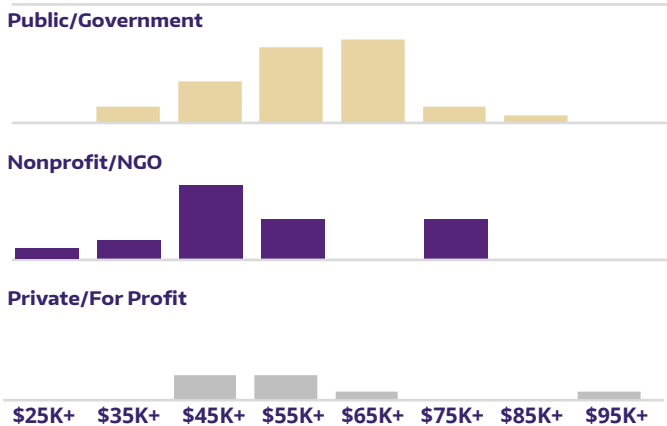
TOP LOCATIONS

While students come to the Evans School from across the US and around the world, most of the Class of 2018 chose to stay in Washington State immediately after graduating.

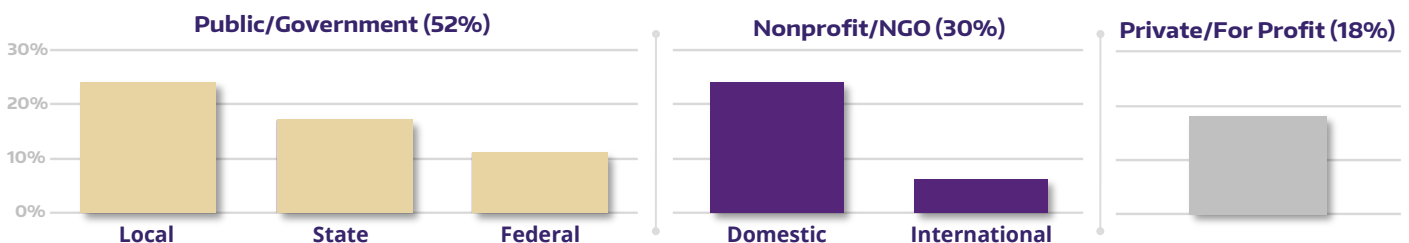


SALARY BY SECTOR
